



Room 200 "The Battle Plan for Prayer"

The Battle Plan for Prayer begins with prayer's core purpose, its biblical design, and its impact throughout history. We will be guided scripturally through the fundamentals of how effective prayer works, inspired towards a closer, more intimate relationship with God, and shown how to develop specific prayer strategies for each area of life. Prayer can accomplish what a willing God can accomplish. It should be your first plan of attack in all of life's battles, not your last resort. If you want to experience the joy of mightily answered prayer, then it's time to engage with God at another level.

Room 202 NIV Standard Lesson - "Ezekiel and the Exile of Judah"

Who were the prophets? Prophets are God's mouthpieces delivering a divine perspective on history, politics, and the behavior of God's people. The November lessons recount Ezekiel's prophetic messages to the people in exile. Join us in Room 202 for lessons about the fall of Jerusalem, Ezekiel's sign, his responsibility and his vision. His ministry helped transform the people into the remnant who find a renewed orientation for hope in the promises of God. Ezekiel died in captivity but his life is a living symbol that God's Word is forever active, present, and powerful.
